Covering an area of over 10,000 square kilometers, Uyuni Salt Flat is the world's largest salt flat located in the southwestern plateau of Potosí Province, Bolivia. Dubbed the legendary "mirror of the sky", Uyuni is famed for its great reflecting properties when a thin layer of water stagnates after a rain. The beautiful and unique sky scenery reflection in the water attracts visitors and photography enthusiasts alike.
