It is considered the gem of Montreal's religious heritage and displays gothic revival-style architecture at its best. It has been, since its foundation, intimately linked to Montreal's history. On top of housing an 8,000-pipe organ with unparalleled acoustics, the Notre-Dame Basilica is a grand theatre of events and an authentic icon of Montreal.
