Description

Originally built in 1365 as part as the town's fortifications and infused with 17th-century paintings and unique features, the Chapel Bridge in Lucerne, Switzerland, quickly became most tourists' favorite site. Together with the iconic Water Tower and an iconic alpine mountain backdrop, the townscape is like no other. Chapel Bridge is also the oldest surviving truss bridge on the planet and the oldest wooden covered bridge in Europe.
