Located south of Cape Town, South Africa, and bordering the Atlantic coast, the rocky promontory named the Cape of Good Hope was discovered by the Portuguese in 1488. The area hosts over 1,100 different plants and flowers, with more than 250 bird species and a diversity of wild animals.
